



**By-law 2018 - 6802**

**Being a bylaw to submit a Question to the Electors on the 2018 Election Municipal Ballot.**

**Whereas** Section 8 of the *Municipal Elections Act, 1996, as amended*, provides that the Council of The Corporation of the Town of Parry Sound (the "Town") may pass a by-law to submit to its electors, subject to section 8.1, a question, the wording of which is established by an Act or a regulation under an Act; and

**Whereas** on January 26, 2016 the Town passed Resolution No. 2016-008 authorizing staff to provide notice to pass a by-law respecting a question on the ballot for the 2018 municipal election regarding fluoridation of the municipal water supply, schedule a public meeting to receive comment on the intended by-law and bring forward a by-law to add the question to the ballot for Council's consideration; and

**Whereas** notice of the intention to pass the by-law was given to the public on the Town of Parry Sound's website and social media commencing January 19, 2018, in the Parry Sound Beacon Star February 3rd and 10th, 2018 and to the Minister of Health and Long-Term Care and the Minister of Municipal Affairs on February 9, 2018; and

**Whereas** a public meeting to consider the matter was held on February 20, 2018 before the by-law was voted on by Town Council; and

**Whereas** the *Fluoridation Act*, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter F.22 states the question to be asked for a vote as to the establishment of a system when the question is being submitted to the electors; and

**Whereas** the *Fluoridation Act*, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter F.22 states where the question receives the affirmative vote of a majority of the electors who vote on the question, the council shall pass the by-law, or, where the question does not receive the affirmative vote of a majority of the electors who vote on the question, the council shall not pass the

by-law until the question has again been submitted to the electors of the municipality and it has received the affirmative vote of a majority of the electors who vote on it.

**Now Therefore The Council Of The Corporation Of The Town Of Parry Sound Enacts As Follows:**

1. That there is hereby submitted to a vote of the electors of the Town of Parry Sound the following question:


*Are you in favour of the fluoridation of the public water supply of this municipality?*

2. The votes of the duly qualified electors of the Town of Parry Sound shall be taken on the said question at the same times and places as those fixed for the Town's 2018 Municipal Election and the said question shall be added to the Town's composite ballot for the 2018 Municipal Election.


