

Accepted Hazardous Waste

Residents of the Archipelago, Carling, McDougall, McKellar, Seguin, and Whitestone can dispose of hazardous waste at the transfer station. Proof of residency is required at all times otherwise the waste will not be accepted. All labels must be legible otherwise the item will not be accepted. Commercial hazardous waste is not accepted. The Hazardous Waste Depot is open from mid-April to mid-October every year. Please check the Town website for exact dates.

The following items are accepted:

- Acid
- Aerosols
- Ammonia
- Anti-Freeze
- Batteries/Car Batteries
- BBQ lighters
- Cleaning Fluids
- Detergents
- Diesel in a sealed container that will not be returned
- Expired/unused medications
- Freon
- Fluorescent Tubes & Bulbs
- Gasoline in a sealed container that will not be returned
- Kerosene
- Motor Oil and Filters
- Paint/Paint Thinners
- Pesticides
- Propane Tanks (non-refillable)
- Syringes/Medical Waste

The following items are not accepted:

- Ammunition
- Asbestos
- Explosives
- Flares
- Pathological or Radioactive
- PCBs
- Roof Shingles
- Unidentified Waste
