

Inspired Filmmaking with an iPod

Each Student Learns About Writing, Shooting, Creating Sound, Directing, and Editing



This innovative film program is designed for a new generation of storytellers. With an unrivaled approach to hands-on, interactive learning, students find themselves completely immersed in their program of study from day one. The story to be told is that of the local World War II vets.

Classes are taught by Mary Jane Gomes an award-winning professional who also taught filming at Ryerson, in a real-world environment with state-of-the-art equipment which is supplied to the students (thanks to the Trillium Foundation) who will work in pairs.

In these film classes, students learn about the key aspects of movie making. Topics of study include producing, directing, art direction, cinematography, screenwriting, postproduction work and sound.

If filmmaking is your passion, attending film school will help put your dream into practice.

Cost: Free as there is a Trillium Foundation Grant covering the \$1,400 cost per student

Where: Bobby Orr Community Centre in the Heart Room

When: 6 – 8 pm on Wednesday evening in November, December and January
6 – 8 pm on Tuesdays in February
9 – 4 pm on January 31st

Other times as required to complete projects – likely to be specific to students needs for filming and editing.

Other Information:

- Students will work in pairs and are encouraged to sign up for the program with a friend.
- 24 students will be accepted into the program.
- We are supplying 12 iPads that are equipped with the appropriate applications and attachments (no cost to the students).
- Some of the early practice can be completed with a smart phone.
- Some time outside of class time may be needed depending on selected project and to practice.
- Filming done during the scheduled trip to Europe may be added on return to Parry Sound.
- Films may be presented to the public during the 3 Pitch Tournament on June 19th and June 20th.
- Films may be presented on YouTube on a Rotary Chanel.
