

Participant Information: Drop-In Programs

Program Dates/Times

- Walking Program: Mondays and Tuesdays from 11 AM – 12 PM
- Pickleball: Wednesdays from 10 AM – 12 PM
- Floor Curling: Wednesdays from 1 – 3 PM
- Shuffleboard: Thursdays from 1 – 3 PM
- Line Dancing: Fridays from 10 AM – 12 PM

Participant Capacities

Participant capacities are based on the space available for a physical distance of 2-metres to be maintained with consideration to program materials that are set up for each program.

Pickleball	10 persons
Floor Curling	16 persons
Shuffleboard	16 persons
Line Dancing	25 persons

Registration

- Registration will be permitted up to 7 days in advance of each program.
- We ask that registrations not be made in person at any program for the following week to give those who are not present at the program a fair chance to participate the following week.

- If a patron calls to register for a program which is full, they will be offered a spot in the program the following week. This will ensure that everyone who wishes to participate will have the opportunity to do so.

Arriving at the Building for your Program

- Entry into the BOCC will be permitted through the main entrance no more than 15 minutes prior to the start of your program. This is to ensure our building staff have time to setup and disinfect rooms prior to welcoming users in for registered programs.
- As of September 22, a vaccine passport is required by the Province of Ontario to enter high-risk indoor public settings, including meeting and event spaces, and facilities used for sports and fitness activities such as recreational facilities. The Town of Parry Sound will require participants to provide proof of double vaccination in accordance with Ontario's Enhanced COVID-19 Vaccine Certificate program.
- Participants will be screened by staff before being permitted to enter the facility. Rules While in the Building

- Maintain 2-metres of physical distancing from those who are not in your household. Please note that it is acceptable for persons to be closer than 2-metres apart where necessary for gameplay.
- Wear a mask that covers the nose, mouth, and chin securely.
- Participants are encouraged to sanitize their hands frequently throughout their visit to the BOCC. Hand sanitizer dispensers are available throughout the facility, and participants are encouraged to bring their own sanitizer for personal use.

At the End of Your Program

- At the end of the program time, building users are asked to exit the building through the side of the building to prevent two-way traffic through the main entrance.
- The facility elevator is available to any patron who requires it.
- Patrons who require an accessible ramp for entry/exit are permitted to exit through the main entrance.

How we are Keeping our Users Safe

- Common areas such as the lobby are cleaned and disinfected at least twice daily (or more often as necessary) to maintain a clean state.
- Lobby washrooms are cleaned and disinfected at least twice daily (or more often as necessary) to maintain a clean state.
- Washrooms in the Hall and Hart room are cleaned and disinfected prior to and/or after scheduled room use to maintain a clean state for user groups.
- Any shared equipment for recreation programs is disinfected prior to and/or after scheduled use to eliminate shared materials between users.

- Chairs will be spaced 2-metres apart around the room where participants can change shoes and leave their belongings during the program. Chairs will be disinfected between user groups.
- Building staff are masked at all times while in publicly accessible portions of the building for the protection of building users and staff.

Subject to Changes

- Please note that the Public Health guidelines for indoor public spaces can change with little to no notice. The Town of Parry Sound reserves the right to alter any of the information contained in this document to meet provincial legislation for opening an indoor public space.
