# **Purpose**

To maintain "Fire Department Issued Uniforms" in serviceable condition.

## **Procedure**

#### 102.1

Any portion of a dress uniform issued by the Town of Parry Sound shall remain the property of the Town.

### 102.2

Uniforms shall be worn only for approved Fire Department activities.

### 102.3

When Fire Department personnel are in uniform, full uniform must be worn, unless a Chief Officer issues order to the contrary.

#### 102.4

Full dress uniform, if issued, will be worn while representing the Fire Department in Court.

#### 102.5

If no uniform is issued, a suit coat and tie will be worn while representing the Fire Department in Court.

#### 102.6

No alcoholic beverages will be consumed while in uniform (exemption may be granted by the Fire Chief).

## 102.7

When dry cleaning is required to keep the uniform serviceable, the Firefighter will have the uniform cleaned and submit the receipt to the Fire Chief for reimbursement of cost.

# Responsibility

It shall be responsibility of every member of the Fire Department to maintain Fire Department Issued Uniforms in serviceable condition, and respect all of the dress uniform regulations.
