# **Purpose**

To clearly identify the required resources to deal with a received emergency request.

## **Procedure**

#### 107.1

**Fire Responses Structural or Unknown:** 

Pump 2 then Tower 1 then Pump 1 then Rescue 1

#### 107.2

Fire Responses (Wildland) Fires:

Pump 1 then Pump 2 then Tower 1 then Rescue 1

### 107.3

**Motor Vehicle Accidents (Includes HAZMAT Responses):** 

Pump 2 then Rescue 1 then units as per request by IC

## 107.4

**Medical Aid Responses:** 

Squad 2 or Squad 1 then Pump 2 then units as per request by IC

### 107.5

Ice/Water Rescue:

Pump 2 and Rescue 1 then Squad 2 and Marine 1

### 107.6

### **High Angle Rescue:**

• Discretionary as per Officer in Charge

# Responsibility

The individual acknowledging the initial request for service and subsequent Incident Commander is responsible to upgrade or downgrade resources as required by the circumstances. This policy is designed to accommodate a majority of responses. There will always be the situation that will not conform to a standard response and will require a deviation from this policy.
