Join our team in the **Parks & Recreation Summer Student** position, an important member of the Public Works department.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities:

1. Provides general labour for a variety of operational and maintenance services for the Corporation's properties, facilities, parks and trails.
2. Operates hand tools and grounds maintenance equipment (e.g. Lawn mowers, trimmers).
3. Completes daily circle checks and inspection reports relative to equipment used.
4. Ensures that a high standard of safety, cleanliness, and technical operation is maintained.
5. Ensures that occupational health and safety practices are strictly observed, and that fire prevention practices and regulations are adhered to.
6. Perform such other related duties within the general parameters of the job as may be reasonably requested by the Manager of Parks & Recreation and/or the Parks & Recreation Lead-Hand.
