Responsibilities:

The Digital Storytelling Intern will collaborate with the Curator on the creation of a new digital exhibit about indigenous sport history in Parry Sound. The Intern's responsibilities will include writing, photographing/scanning artifacts, and constructing the digital exhibit website. Additionally, the Intern will assist in the organization and management of a community event at the Hall of Fame, curating temporary physical exhibits in the museum, manage digital communications streams and assist in the procurement and implementation of a new Hall of Fame website. The role focuses on digital storytelling and communications to support traditional museum offerings.
