Eligibility

The person you nominate (the nominee) must:

- have contributed to the community after the age of 65
- be a resident of Parry Sound

Seniors who qualify for this award may have contributed to many different fields such as the arts, literature, community service, volunteering, education, environment, fitness, and humanitarian activities.

You cannot nominate:

- yourself
- someone who has passed away
- someone currently holding political office
- elected federal, provincial, municipal representatives or political appointees

 - b) be able to explain the value and impact of the nominee's achievements.
 - c) support the nomination. Include the testimonial writers' first name, last name, email address and phone number.
- 3. You may include optional supporting documents to give more insight into your nominee's accomplishments, such as:
 - a) supplementary testimonials.
 - b) publications.
 - c) media stories and news articles.
