Join our **Aquatics Program Summer Student** team as a **Lifeguard or Swim Instructor**. The primary purpose of these roles is to provide a safe and clean waterfront and swim instruction program.

Essential Duties & Responsibilities:

1. Handling emergencies that occur in the beach and park area
2. Assisting with the daily maintenance and operations of the beach and park area
3. Assisting in organizing, planning and implementing special events at the beach
4. Assisting in completing the required daily facility checklists, accident and incident reporting

Education, Experience, Knowledge, Skills:

1. National Lifeguard Waterfront (required)
2. Standard First Aid and CPR Level C
3. Lifesaving Society Instructor (LSI) (required for Instructors only)
4. High level of organization and record keeping skills.
5. High level of teamwork and cooperation skills.
6. Good communication and public relations skills.
7. Must be 15 years of age or older.
8. Previous lifeguarding experience is an asset.
