Town of Parry Sound to Begin Weekly Water Testing at Waubuno Beach

The Town of Parry Sound is advising residents and visitors that the North Bay Parry Sound District Health Unit has discontinued routine beach water sampling in the area. As a result, Waubuno Beach will no longer receive the monthly bacteria testing previously conducted by the Health Unit.

Town staff believe that ongoing water monitoring remains extremely important for the safety and peace of mind of our beach users and lifeguards. In response to this change, the Town of Parry Sound will begin weekly beach water testing at Waubuno Beach starting June 29, 2026. Testing will continue through August 31, 2026.

Water testing results will be posted weekly on the Lifeguard Office door for public viewing.

The Town would also like to remind residents and visitors that the Waubuno Beach Lifeguard team will begin guarding seven days per week from 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. starting June 27, 2026.

The Town remains committed to supporting a safe and enjoyable waterfront experience for all residents and visitors throughout the summer season.
