



Taxi Licence

The Town license both taxicab drivers and taxicab owners. There is an approval process for both types of licence.

Taxi owners

Taxi owners (vehicles) are licensed for public health and safety reason and to ensure that taxis are in good mechanical condition. The municipal licensing by-law requires:

- Completion of an application
- Proof of 1,000,000 liability insurance;
- Proof of ownership of the vehicle; and
- Ministry of Transportation Mechanical Safety Check

Taxi drivers

Taxi drivers are licensed to ensure the driver is licensed to drive by the province and to protect the consumer. The municipal licensing by-law requires that a taxi driver:

- be over the age of 18 years;
- holds a valid Ontario drivers licence; and
- has a favourable police background check.

If you are interested in driving a taxicab you need to contact one of the local taxi companies. The local taxi company will conduct an interview and upon hire they will provide you with the appropriate paperwork to submit to the Issuer of Licences.

Taxi Identification

It is recommended that you select and ride in a licensed taxicab. A licensed taxicab will have a numbered plate on the right side of the rear bumper and a roof sign. A licensed taxicab driver will have displayed a driver's photo identification and information on who to contact to register a compliment or complaint about service.
